Procedures

Riverview Sickness Policy

For the wellbeing of all, kids should not be brought to church if they have, or have had in the last 24 hours:

- Fever (greater than 100.4)
- Diarrhea
- Any known contagious childhood disease (e.g., chicken pox)
- Sore throat
- Croup and/or productive cough
- Any skin infection or unexplained rash
- Pink eye
- Nasal discharge of color
- Common cold

When a child has received antibiotic medication for 24 hours, and is feeling well, they may be brought back to church.

Preschool

Arrival/Check-In

1. Families may check in at 9:15 at the preschool welcome or the children's check-in desk (located underneath the south awning before you enter the fellowship hall.)
2. Please adhere to six feet markers on floor for social distancing purposes.
3. Temperatures will be taken for **ALL** kids (and volunteers) before check in is complete.
4. Babies-3's may be escorted by **ONE** parent to their classroom. Pre-K and Kindergarten will be escorted by a Riverview Kids volunteer.
5. Mask are optional for both volunteers and kids and will not be provided.

Classroom Procedures

1. Preschool volunteers have been asked to be vigilante in the classroom to help children interact in a safe manner (social distancing at this age is difficult)
2. Each room will be equipped with hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes.
3. Pre-K and Kindergarten children will be given a Ziploc bag with their name on it for the implements they use during the session. These implements will be used each week for the foreseeable future
4. Toys that are mouthed will be placed in a bucket to be sanitized after the session.
5. All preschool rooms are sanitized after each session by our Preschool Caretaker.
6. Any child that is found to be ill during a session will be removed from the classroom immediately, parents will be notified, and the contaminated room will be closed until sanitization can take place.

Check-out/Pick up Procedure

1. Parent's are asked to wait at the preschool check-in desk until the preschool volunteer tells you to go back.
2. **ALL** family members are permitted to pick up a preschool child at this time.
3. Families will then exit the preschool hall via the south exit door at the end of the preschool hall.
4. Families are asked to notify Mrs. Kristie or Mrs. Carissa if a child becomes sick, has direct contact with someone who is positive for COVID 19, or test positive for COVID 19 themselves after attending a session at Riverview.

1st-6th Grades

Arrival/Check-In

1. Families may check in at 9:15 at the preschool welcome or the children's check-in desk (located underneath the south awning before you enter the fellowship hall.)
2. Temperatures will be taken for **ALL** kids (and volunteers) before check in is complete and children will receive a security tag.
3. Kids will then be escorted up to the Kid Zone by a Riverview Kids volunteer.

Classroom Procedures

1. Children will be placed at desk or in chairs that are socially distanced.
2. Mask are optional for both workers and children and will not be provided.
3. Children will be given a Ziploc bag with their name on it for the implements they use during the session. These implements will be used each week for the foreseeable future.
4. Children are encouraged to bring their OWN Bible to class.
7. Each room will be equipped with hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes.
8. Each classroom room will have a sanitize bucket for items that may need to be sanitized after the session.
9. Any child that is found to be ill during a session will be removed from the classroom immediately, parents will be notified, and the contaminated room will be closed until sanitization can take place.
10. Classrooms will be sanitized after each session.

Check Out/Dismissal

1. Parent will need pick up children from Sunday School downstairs in fellowship hall promptly at 10:30 with their family security tag.
2. Families are asked to notify Mrs. Carissa if a child becomes sick, has direct contact with someone who is positive for COVID 19, or test positive for COVID 19 themselves after attending a session at Riverview
